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better than expected...



erasmus+: what, when, who, how much?

- an EU programme for general education, job training, youth and sport.
- coordinated by the national agencies (NA) of the respective countries
- YOUTH IN ACTION, LEONARDO DA VINCI and GRUNDTVIG, COMENIUS, ERASMUS, SPORT
- a programme for 7 years, from 2014 to 2020
- € 14.7 billion -> 40% rise



- non-formal and informal education for young people
- budget of € 1.47 billion -> 70% rise
- Three funding sectors (Key actions)
 - Key Action 1: Educational mobility of persons (youth encounters, EVS, mobility of professionals)
 - Key Action 2: Collaboration to support innovation and to exchange proven methods
 - Key Action 3: Supporting political reforms



erasmus+: YOUTH IN ACTION New developments in general

- schools and social enterprises can apply
- applicants and all partner organisations have to register in Brussels
- Funding mainly as lump sums
- Several projects can be jointly applied for (max. duration 24 months)

erasmus+: YOUTH IN ACTION New developments in general

- more focused on: efficiency and effectiveness
- clear european benefits

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- effects on individuals, organisations and systems
- Collaboration across sectors
 - High visibility and reusability of materials and content



erasmus+: YOUTH IN ACTION New developments in general

- 30 points: relevance of the project (min. 15)
 - fits the priorities of the programme, the needs of the partner organisations and the participants
 - relevantly improves the european profile of applicants and partner organisations
 - is geared towards marginalised youths
- 40 points: project design / implementation (min. 20)
 - non-formal education, participation of all partners, certificaion
- 30 points: effects and dissemination (min. 15)
 - evaluation
 - effect on participants and organisations
 - dissemination on persons and organisations not directly involved
 - TOTAL minimum 60 points



Mobility for youths and professionals (KA1)

- youth encounters
 - 13 to 30 years
 - min 16 max 60 participants
 - lump sums
 - multiple projects in one application
 - increased visibility, effectiveness
 (internationalisation), dissemination



Mobility for youths and professionals (KA1)

- EVS
 - 17 to 30 years
 - Lump sums and flat rates
- mobility measures for professionals
 - trainings, seminars, partner contact seminars, educational travel, job shadowing
 - no funding for prepared visits, evaluation, networking
 - more flexibility regarding the duration (2 days to 2 months)

Mobility for youths and professionals (KA1)

- Funding:
 - -special needs support (disabilities):
 - 100% of the costs incurred, as proven by receipts
 - -exceptional costs (visa, vaccinations etc.):
 - 100% of the costs incurred, as proven by receipts



erasmus+: Collaboration to support innovation and to exchange proven methods (KA2)

- strategic partnerships
- -capacity building
 - strategic cooperation between programme countries and nonprogramme countries (youth organisations and public institutions)
 - cooperation between youth / educational sector and institutions on the job market (companies, job centre, etc.)
- knowledge alliances (universities companies)
- sector skills alliances (job training)
 - cooperation for strengthening and further education in different job sectors



- medium to long term projects (up to 2 years)
- innovations in the educational sector with sustainable effect on the participating organisations and on a systematic level
- bridging different sectors



- expected effects:
 - higher quality of the educational system and better adaptation to the job market
 - greater synergies between educational sector and youth sector
 - increased cooperation between public institutions in the educational and youth sector
 - Innovative and attractive programmes and methods
 - Strengthening the ability to work on a European level

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- Possible activities:
 - meetings to exchange knowledge on best practices
 - development, testing and implementation of new methods
 - collaboration of youth and educational sector
 - collaboration of public institutions
 - Transnational youth initiatives

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- Funding
 - project management (€ 500 / €250 per month)
 - transnational meetings (kilometre flat rate)
 - intellectual products (€39 €294 per person / day)
 - meetings of multipliers (lump sum €100 within the country / €200 abroad)
 - transnational education and training activities (kilometre flat rate)
 - Exceptional costs (75%) and special support (100%)



erasmus+: Key action 3 Supporting political reforms

- Knowledge in the field of education, training and youth
- Prospective initiatives
- Support for European policy tools
- Cooperation with international organisations
- Stakeholder dialogue, policy and programme promotion (structured dialogue)
